Practicalities

The patio garden is fully enclosed.

Litton Shop sells dog food. Turn right out of the front door and walk for 3 minutes. Tideswell General Stores and Tideswell Coop also sell dog food. (See Welcome Folder in the cottage for opening times).

If your pet needs a bath, there is a bucket, towels and shampoo in the back porch. Please bath on the patio or in the kitchen.

Please 'scoop all poop' your dog does in the village and on the patio. There is a bin next to the phone box on the green.

Please do not let your dog go upstairs or on the furniture.

Please keep your dog on the lead if there is ANY RISK that he/she will chase sheep or cows. Farmers can legally shoot dogs caught chasing their stock.

We have been chased by cows with calves - be cautious around cattle!

Please do not leave your dog unattended in the garden.

Transport

Local bus services operated by Hulleys take dogs. For dogs you pay a flat fare of 60p per journey.
